






Editorial:

A Shortage Of Power

Some years back while in college, I had my airplane parked just outside the college and I was often found at the airport after classes, as I never saw a landing

that I didn't want to watch. I have always watched as the airplanes took off in flight and then watched them as they come back to land, what a beautiful sight! I listened as one of the pilots called in and let us know he was inbound for landing, but had only partial power, just enough to keep him flying toward the airport. He continued to talk and let us know that the throttle control had come loose and that he had gotten partial power by continually jamming the throttle until it caught just enough to give him partial power and hopefully he could make the airport. He finally puttered on in and made an uneventful landing for which we all were very thankful, especially the pilot.

I have told you this little story to help you remember that we have experienced a Power Shortage here at headquarters during the months of December, January and February. It has caused us to function with some problems and delays. We have been forced to put some things off, cancel some and just continue the approach with only partial power. Our desire was and is to get everything done on time and keep up the good pace which we have been used to, but it wasn't possible with only two of us working full time here at headquarters. I had to go into the hospital for one month back in December of last year and then continue therapy at home and I am still under the therapy

at this time. I should be fully recovered about December of 2018 if the doctor is correct. The pilot in the story had all the power just in front of his legs that he would ever need to get him back to the airport, but he was limited because he could not access the power because of the broken control. I found myself in a similar situation, Sister Wilkins was all the power we needed in our office, but I needed her with me to help power me until I was better and that she did. There was no way that we could get the all work done with both of us out of the office. I do hope that you will understand and give us some time to catch up with the work.

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. by someone? It means that someone has control over us by either influence or power to force us into compliance with their values and ideas of what is proper or required. The dictionary gives us this explanation: govern-to exercise authority over; rule, administer direct, control, manage, etc. 2 - to influence the action or conduct of; guide; sway public opinion. Many of us know that in the form of government we have, which is THEO-CRATIC, our role is one of submission to the Holy Ghost, because if He doesn't guide us then we crash. Our leaders are under submission to Him also and that is why it works so well. Those over us in the Lord are just as much submitted as we are so then when they teach us and ask us to do things we obey, because of submission. We are governed in The Church of God by the Holy Ghost. Did you ever hear someone say, "I don't care what my pastor says; I will obey God rather than man." Now that is what the Bible says for us to do, but it is about the spirit of the man that says something like that. Does he/she say these words while angry with the pastor or upset with the International Assembly? This could be a bad statement if made out of angry thoughts and actions. In order to obey God in a theocratic government, we must keep ourselves quiet and permit

What does it mean to be governed Him to speak and sometimes He speaks to us through our pastors and other leaders. Theocratic Government is government by the immediate direction of God. Pure Theocracy operates on three fundamental truths; theocracy is the law given by God, the rule under the direction of God and the willing submission to God by the people. It will not work until all three of these principles are prominent in the practice of Theocratic Government. His people must be willing to accept these principles in order to be "His Church" and nothing else will work to build His Church. The question is; ARE WE WILLING? When we join the Church, we do so by taking a covenant which is between God and us and here is what we say; "I Will" and that makes us a member by covenant which is perpetual and will always stand even when we backslide and the Church removes fellowship with us. That doesn't end the covenant; it shall never be forgotten by our God and will stand against us or for us in the judgement by God.

> The Church of God is one of the most dividing, splitting Churches in the world, just since 1903 we have split more than 33 times and that is a shame, because Christ prayed for us to remain one. Listen to His words in John 17:

I have manifested thy name unto

the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one,

While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them. and I in them. John 17:6-26

Does these few verses of Scripture make you think of a diversified church which is now being taught? If you don't like what we preach either find one you do like or better yet start a new one. Do you think if Bishop A. J. Tomlinson could come and sit in some of the so-called Church of God services that he would recognize them as THE CHURCH OF GOD that he left? He would probably think he

was in a denominal church! Imagine Bishop M. A. Tomlinson who died a few years back coming into one of our services today to find that the teachings which he promoted until the day of his death has been replaced by articles of faith and other summaries of the faith. The covenant is replaced or missing entirely from the reception of new members. Saints this is not what these two men were about and it is time for us to arise and preach the doctrine and practices again just as they preached and taught.

The Spirit of God has departed from these places where the doctrine is no longer a part of their churches and the pastors are taking in the members in double marriage and some of the members feel they have been forsaken. It is so sad when we stop to think about what is happening. We never thought that the Church of God would ever lower Her standard, but man has done it and the members stood and watched as committees ruled out the holiness doctrine and subscribed to the doctrine of devils. God will always have a remnant that will not bend or bow! They will continue to walk in His Word and maintain the doctrine for those who want it. I am thankful that God will not permit Bishop A. J. Tomlinson and Bishop M. A. Tomlinson to see the ruins of what they were willing to give their lives for. It would look like to them that their years of sacrifice and hard work were washed away and that the sins of man had taken over all the good hearts and minds of the Church. They would weep and tears would flow from their eyes like rivers as they looked at the rubble and waste called the church today. Those who will come out and dare to keep the faith are just a

remnant, but if God builds the house it will not be in vain! When Bishop Tomlinson was preaching there at Bible Place on a fish box with only a hand full standing with him, it seemed to many that it was hopeless but no, because God took over and it became once again a strong house that Jesus built. If our house is ever strong it will be because Jesus built it! What do you say that we rise up in faith and build the house together with Jesus Christ the Head of the Church? This is all about Him and He has been the Head since the beginning. God is in charge! There will be a remnant saved and they will not cave in when the committees and executives give their reports and try to take our properties. The Church will survive without compromise. How many will continue is the big question. The number does not matter, but the covenant does.

Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved: For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth. Romans 9:27-28

But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace. Romans 11:4-5

When men start up new churches to present their own selfish theologies and unrestrained religious philosophies they are in violation of the scriptures given in this message, read again Jesus Christ's own

words in John 17. We do not have to worry about these men, because their works will come to naught in the end. I recently heard this man building up one of the leaders of one of these churches who probably should be serving time in prison for his past actions, but God has it all in His hands. My concern is for the Church of God which is that, because of Her actions, not some man or some committee. No man shall survive who knows more than the Assembly or the Overseer whom he serves under and is willing to tell either his views with a robust disrespectful spirit. Over the years I have watched them fall prey to their own fleshly spirit and seen them stand in defiance during the Assembly and have little respect for their overseer or the Assembly. Then God very quietly removes them from their office and in some cases they do not even live. We have been talking about the Church being governed by the Holy Ghost and willing people submitting to that governance in the fear of God, but how many will hear what I have said? Probably only a few, but a few led by God can remove mountains.

Without our leaders who have been filled with the Holy Ghost and their guidance where would we be today? How about our International Assembly, where would we be if everyone felt the assembly was of no use to us. It is there that we receive instruction from the Lord and He often speaks to us in a voice we can understand.

I remember and Assembly not very long ago where a teaching was being added and the Holy Ghost took over and changed a short passage in that teaching which made it unquestionable and it has been challenged by doctors without success, because it was what God wanted. Without the assembly and those who watch for our souls we would have no Church! It is not every man for himself, to start up new churches and teach whatever feels good or sounds good. We have enough of those already doing that. It is time for us to preach and teach the doctrine of The Church of God from the Bible.

Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein. We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle. For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp. Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach. For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come. By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for

you. Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. But I beseech you the rather to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner. Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:17-21

When we lose our respect for those over us in the Lord we are at the same time losing our sanctification and the spirit of God can no longer guide us. It is the power of God in us that causes us to respect our elders and obey them as they watch for our souls. Paul said, "Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ." I Corinthians 11:1

We are given no right to make light of what our leaders say or to belittle them as though they had no authority to tell us anything. One of the problems we have had is the members doing this in their homes and in front of their children so that virtually all respect is lost for our pastors and overseers. They can be wrong and our responsibility is to follow them as they follow Christ as we have been instructed by the Apostle Paul. Some have the idea that they can tell their pastor off anytime they want to and it will be alright, but that is not true. As we walk in theocratic government let us learn that we must obey those over us in the Lord and respect them for their area of responsibility and watch care for our souls. God's government only functions when people submit to His will and obey those over them.

Your pastor, overseer and other leaders deserve your respect and loyalty as long as they are following the Lord.

Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that the LORD he is God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else. Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong thy days upon the earth, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, for ever.

Deuteronomy 4:39-40

God is it, there is no other and we must keep His statutes and His commandments.

That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

This message is one about governance by obedience! When we are willing to obey the Holy Ghost we don't even have to worry about how we will treat each other because He will check us. We will be governed by Him and willingly walk with each other in submission and love. He will have a Church that loves one another and there will be no one telling the others off without care for their souls.

Matthew 10: 34, 35, 36

34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. 35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. 36 And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.

In this passage Jesus is speaking of a time when truth and sound doctrine will not be accepted by many and those who do hold to it, will be persecuted. In our last International Assembly to my surprise I was appointed as our International Women's Missionary Director. Since that time of course I have been pondering this appointment and praying about it. I ask for your prayers for the Lord's inspiration and guidance. Although I have held many jobs within the church, this is a new one for me. I accept this appointment in the fear of the Lord and I do not take it lightly. You see I have had the privilege from my youth to meet and witness the leadership of several International Directors. One that left such an impression on me was Sister Sylvia Hardin. This is such a great responsibility and I have shared my inward heart with the Lord. If I can only accomplish a small portion of those before me I would feel very honored.

There is a program I read from time to time on the internet called "Face Book". In this program different people post and share their "Fond Memories of the Church". The definition of the word memory is 1. the faculty by which the mind stores and remembers information.. 2. something remembered from the past; a recollection. The memories shared here are wonderful memories to reflect upon. Although I have never posted any of my memories I would like to share some of mine in this, my introduction of myself as your International WMB Director.

In the April 29, 1989 issue of the White Wing Messenger his Editorial title was, "ALMOST HOME". Below is what he wrote.

"ALMOST HOME!"

What a welcome announcement for those who have traveled a long way, who perhaps are weary from the trip. Home is what they long for as they travel the last few miles. Most of us can identify with the comfort this announcement brings.

Many began a spiritual pilgrimage many years ago, and today they are on the final part of their journey. They found themselves in a world which they recognized was not their home. Like those to whom Peter wrote his epistle, they knew that they, too, were "strangers and pilgrims" (1 Peter 2:11) on this earth.

The journey has not always been pleasant. Some parts of it have been very enjoyable, but some segments have been painful; however, they knew they were headed for home and that the trip would not last forever. They just kept forging ahead.

Jesus' promise, " I go to prepare a place for you," has special meaning as they get nearer home. They know He will be there, and to have Him welcome them home will be the zenith of their joy upon arrival. Of course, there are others they will want to see. After all, all those who are there to greet them will be members of the family, brothers and sisters whom they love and who love them. What a homecoming!

The last few miles will be ones of eager anticipation. **Almost home!**

I knew then he was excited about the future of this great event of going home. Then the day came, he stepped down (retired) due to poor health. I believe, Brother Tomlinson could join Paul in saying, "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing. 2 Timothy 4:7–8

Brother Tomlinson knew this earth was not his home. He knew "The Church of God" was not "His Church" but it was "Christ's Church".

Peter knew this was Christ's Church. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. Matthew 16:18

Paul knew this was Christ's Church, he told the people, "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. Acts 20: 28
