the clock.


The thunder rolled, light left the sky,

Over the last year we have had multiple problems with those who promote themselves to be wise, far above The Church of God and Her leadership. I have been with them and they would take the service over and just speak in tongues and declare that the Church was behind in understanding and doctrine. I along with some others have tried to get them to look at the Bible regarding these matters, but they refused to look at the Bible or receive counsel on the matters and now some are out of the Church because of this. When a young Christian looks at the Regional Overseer, National Overseer and the International Overseer and says, "Don't expect them to

hear you because they won't listen to you, they do not believe that what we have is the Holy Ghost Holding fast the faithful teaching us." When you hear these things you need to pay close attention to the Word of God rather than your leader who utters these things because the leader just might be in error with the spirit of the Anti-Christ. He wants to be out front and he wants to be listened to as he projects his will rather than the will of the Lord Jesus Christ. Everything you hear speaking in tongues is not the Holy Ghost of God. He has a humble and quiet spirit not one demanding attention. The tongue talkers are everywhere in the world and often what they are saying in conflict with the Word of God. When the Holy Ghost speaks he is always in complete harmony with the Bible and He doesn't give you directions for your life that do not conform to the Word. You must try the spirits to see if they be of God. When you question these people, they get mad and really possessive and they quickly tell you not to listen to your headquarters or your leadership, but rather to move quickly against them. Some time ago we had to deal with some of this business and maybe one or two really good members got caught up in this and will possibly be lost because of it. This is shameful, but this is what happens when the spirit of the Anti-Christ is permitted to work for just a little time. Our job one is to protect the Church from these, and there will be more of them in the future, because the time is now short and Satan is making a big push. God will alert His Church and we need not worry about new revelations and signs. They are coming through our back doors rather than being introduced through the right sources and when they are false they must be confronted openly by our leadership for what they are. It is time to

become fully alert to the false gods and spirits of the underworld. I have been confronted by these demonic spirits and had them call me names right in the Church during this past year but please do not worry about them, because God will smite them without warning and put an end to their foolishness in due time. We are without fear, because of the Holy Ghost warning us over and over regarding these confrontations. We must be prayed up, waiting on the leading of the Lord and everything else will be all right. God has given us His Word; He will take care of us. We must trust Him and obey Him and not allow some smooth talking person to influence us to hear them instead.

A lady who was a wonderful child of God called me some time ago and told me about the Holy Ghost Messages that had been given out in a church she had visited and how that the Lord was working in that place. I knew about some of the people there so I asked her how many of these giving messages were living with their real companion and she got real quite. You see God does not give messages and interpretations to those who live in adultery with someone else's husband or wife.

It is the same as a bank robber telling someone, "I am saved now; the Lord has forgiven me of robbing banks." Then he goes back and robs another bank and just continues to teach Sunday School down at the local church. Yes. God will save a bank robber, but he must quit robbing banks and live the life. We don't fool God and when He saves us we must give the wife that we have taken from another man back to him in order to be saved in the end. Yes, words do matter and some have stood before God's altar and lied to one woman after another or one man after another without much regard. This is the spirit of the Anti-Christ at work in our day. In my early life a lot of churches condemned this behavior and His Church still does.

And Jesus answered and said unto them. Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not vet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ve shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a

witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. Matthew 24:4-14

Jesus cared enough to warn us that they were coming. It is now time to grab this idea and understand that Christians are losing their heads as I write this message. Their heads are being cut off, they are being shot, and they are beaten just because they are Christian. It is high time that we realize the end is near as more and more of our liberties are taken and it gets harder and harder to serve the Lord openly, even in America. Jesus has taught us that we will be hated and betraved by some we call brothers and sisters.

We have lived for and longed for a time when we would be loved and appreciated by our brothers and sisters in the Lord. We have needed their support and love in order to be able to stand and fight for the Lord in these last days, but now we learn that those we trust must be carefully selected and observed before we completely put our lives on the line with them. They are put to the test by the Lord and some will not make it. Listen to the Bible!

Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. Matthew 7:21-23

When you hear those who want you to believe that they have the gifts of healing, spiritual discernment, prophecy and other things, please beware of their craftiness, because these gifts are placed

into the Church to be used by the Church. Just standby and wait and watch to see just how long these lift up the name, of Jesus, because many times they are wanting their name to be lifted up instead. We must lift up His name not man's name. When a child of God is living close to the Lord and the Spirit says for them to pray for someone and they obey God the healing will be performed by the Lord. They are doing the work of the Church by the same power of God without actually being in the Body of Christ by covenant. Jesus told His disciples to leave them alone! These gifts however, were given to the Church, not to individuals to be used as they see fit. I knew an evangelist one time who had a pretty big name throughout the United States and would say, "If the Lord healed you don't forget to tell who prayed for you." I did not find that to be amusing or worthwhile. When God is not receiving the glory for these miracles, then it is done in the wrong spirit and will soon come to naught. This man was soon gone from the Church.

We are still looking at words that matter and realizing that we are accountable for every idle word. Our goal is to glorify God with our words and honor Him in all things we do.

For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. 1 Peter 3:10-12

I have seen evil done against some of our good people and we can all rest assured that evil will be punished by the God

we serve; it will not be overlooked nor ignored. We must not claim to love them and do evil behind their back. Often a man or woman will say, "I love you" without one thought of what it really means to love someone with an "Agape" love. The term is abused, misused and in many cases just a habit which is repeated without thought and meaningless.

One way to recognize him is to listen to not just what he is saying, but the spirit in which it is delivered. He often knows more than anyone else, and has the answer for the whole Church and is ready to line up those who have carried the load of the Church for many years. He is not respectful of anyone, but himself and will badger and blast any who get in his way if they challenge him. He usually has the answers to all questions and speaks as one having great authority and power.

Let us speak the Word of God with power, dignity, authority and love in humility and honor to the Christ which we represent, knowing we are accountable for all of our words.

Theodore "Ted" J. Lowe

The Church of God has lost another soldier to his eternal reward; Bishop Theodore J. Lowe has finished his assignment on earth and moved on to his home which is permanent with Jesus Christ in Heaven. I knew him as a friend for many



years and always looked him up during our General Assembly where we literally spent hours talking about old times and our experiences through the years. I will miss these times greatly, but we have both been preparing for this change for a long time and it will come, if the Lord tarries for all of us. I can only imagine the great joy he is now experiencing in the presence of the Lord.

He was born to Taylor J. Lowe and Velma Ruth Osbourne Lowe on February 11, 1929 in Borger, Texas. He then moved to Melrose, New Mexico and fell in love with his lifelong sweetheart, Jetta Lee Leeder and married her on March 9, 1947. From this union came two sons, Thurman J. on December 14, 1947 and Herman J. on October 29, 1948.

He was saved in 1940, called into the ministry in 1952, ordained a Bishop in 1955 during the General Assembly in Cleveland, Tennessee. He served as pastor for 30 years and was State Overseer for some 20 years. His loyalty to The Church of God was proven through the years and the turmoil by the enemy, but did not unseat him as a minister, ever. When he slipped away his file was pulled and his reports were there even for his final month, this shows his dedication and faithfulness in reporting. He has left us an example to follow as ministers in The Church of God.

Bishop Lowe is survived by his wife of 68 years, Jetta Lee Lowe of Hobbs, NM. He has two sons Thurman Lowe and wife Darlene of Hobbs and Herman Lowe and his wife Nellie of Magna, UT. For 64 years he has carried the message of Jesus Christ and His Church to untold numbers of people. He will be greatly missed by all of us that knew him and treasured his warmth and kindness, but we look for our meeting in Heaven after this life is finished for us. As Christ arose on that first Easter morning, so let us also "awake out of sleep," for our salvation, through His death on the cross, is nearer than when we first believed.—

The Church of God of North Carolina has lost one of the greatest man of God in the country of Philippines. This man serves throughout his life until God call him in his eternal home.




