


THE 105th INTERNATIONAL ASSEMBLY

ZIMBABWE, AFRICA



"OBEDIENCE IS BETTER THAN SACRIFICE"

And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. 1 Sam 15:22

Many have sacrificed greatly for the Lord and the message of The Church of God. They have gone without many of the things their family needed and wanted in order to please the Lord. Their lives have been sold out to God and the sacrifices they have made have kept them poor and living in houses that were not desirable at times. Sometimes their children have grown up not liking their conditions and have rebelled against God and the Church. I have known personally a few that would stop at nothing legal and decent in order to work in the vineyard of the Lord and that is commendable to a point. I have sacrificed at times in order to put money into the Church rather than take money out, but if we do that without obedience, then we are only fooling ourselves. To obey is what it takes to

be perfect in Christ Jesus. When we are committed to obey Him, we are well on our way to perfection and this is where the Devil will approach us to turn us around.

Some of the great Church of God preachers of our time have done the above, but later in life became bitter and confused. to the point of doing things that, they thought a few years before, they could never do. An example is like changing the doctrine and preaching a new liberal message that their family and friends would like; one that could be tolerated among all the family while God's Word never leads us to do this because it says, Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ve not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

James 4:4

If we sacrifice all the world and then refuse to obey God, our work is in vain, and God will not accept a disobedient person in His Kingdom, not to mention His Church.

In the text verse, God is giving instructions that every living thing is to be destroyed, but when they got there, the spoil started to look like something they wanted to sacrifice to the Lord, so they started gathering the spoil. The Word of the Lord is

given to Saul and his requirement is to keep it, not change it for convenience or to improve upon it.

Samuel sends Saul to destroy Amalek

Samuel also said unto Saul, The LORD sent me to anoint thee to be king over his people, over Israel: now therefore hearken thou unto the voice of the words of the LORD. 1 Sam 15:1

Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass. 1 Sam 15:3

Now what was so difficult about the things that were told to Saul by Samuel? God had said to destroy everything and he was to hearken unto the Words of the Lord and spare nothing. Now, flesh started to work, and a better plan was in the making as they moved to carry out the Word from the Lord as they saw the spoil was good and desirable. In verse 8 we find the beginning of sorrows because Saul turned from doing the spoken Word of the Lord in sparing some things which should have been destroyed.

And he took Agag the king of the Amalekites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword. But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all that was good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing that was vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly. 1 Sam 15:8-9

Many today who have done likewise before the Lord, say that they are still alright and they are still committed to doing the Lord's will but they, like Saul, have failed and God will reject them as he did Saul. No doubt that Saul really wanted to do what God had said, but the flesh was weak.

God rejects Saul for his disobedience

Then came the word of the LORD unto Samuel, saying, It repenteth me that I have set up Saul to be king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night. And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal. And Samuel came to Saul: and Saul said unto him, Blessed be thou of the LORD: I have performed the commandment of the LORD.

And Samuel said, What meaneth then this bleating of the sheep in mine ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear? And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed. Then Samuel said unto Saul, Stay, and I will tell thee what the LORD hath said to me this night. And he said unto him, Say on. And Samuel said, When thou wast little in thine own sight, wast thou not made the head of the tribes of Israel, and the LORD anointed thee king

over Israel?

And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed. Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?

And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal. And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD?

Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king. 1 Sam 15:10-23

It is still evil to disobey God regardless of the sacrifice and self-giving attitude of the individual. Many have turned their backs on the Lord after promising Him that they would never turn away but would preach and defend the gospel at any cost to them. They now preach and teach that having another man's wife is okay under certain circumstances and conditions, but it still isn't true no matter who says it and who condones it. The Bible, God's Word is true.

For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged. Romans 3:3-4

When Samuel approached Saul for accountability, Saul said, "I have performed the commandment of the LORD." It was a lie and mattered not that it came from the King's mouth; it was still a lie and disqualified him from being King. Many are disqualified from being the Lord's overseers because they have lied and are no longer worthy of that office. Their lies are no different form lies told by layman; they are certifiable as lies, and disqualify these from being leaders. The Church of God is right and God will have a people called by His name that will preach the gospel and defend it against all of those who refuse. They will be the People of God, THE CHURCH OF GOD, the Church of Prophecy, not just in name, but in action of presenting holiness and righteousness in God to a lost and hopeless world without Christ. Now Samuel asked him what does the bleating of the sheep mean if you have told me the truth? What is the lowing of the oxen in my ears if you have spoken to me the truth? Why are the sheep and oxen still alive if you have complied with the Word of the Lord? We are still accountable to God, regardless of what the Supreme Court does in these United States of America. No matter what the Deacon Board says or the Overseer says, you better be obedient to God if you want to win. Some say, "Well let me call the overseer and see what he says about this or if he will go along with it." You may be getting into trouble if he is not following the Word of God. Let me restate that, you are already in trouble if you are consulting with the overseer, because you are accountable to the God who has called you into the ministry.

Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.

This is the reply given by Samuel to Saul for what he had already done against God. How would you like to hear that reply in regards to what you have already done? To obey is better than all the sacrifice you could ever make for the Lord. He wants us to all obey Him and be perfect in His sight. You will never get more perfected than fully obeying God! Many have feared the people and families and have reneged on obeying the Lord, but it will be to their demise. I have two sons and one daughter, but if either of them takes a second companion while their first is alive, they have sinned against God and God will hold them accountable for their actions. God will not allow me or you to condone this action because they are our children, and if you do this, you will be a failure for the Lord, just as Saul was a failure and ultimately rejected from being King. Many will be missing in Heaven, because they have been guilty of petting this sin in their children, brothers and sisters, fathers and mothers. We must reprove it and warn them against this sin, just as other sins, lest we be guilty of aiding and abetting sin. It will not get you elected as Pastor of the Year or put you in good light with all the family, but we are accountable to God to hold on to the truth and warn every man, woman, boy and

girl to avoid this sin. The ministers who have forgotten this will be searching for relief from the awfulness of the flames of Hell if they do not repent and come back in humiliation before the Lord.

Saul's humiliation

And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD. And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel. And as Samuel turned about to go away, he laid hold upon the skirt of his mantle, and it rent. And Samuel said unto him, The LORD hath rent the kingdom of Israel from thee this day, and hath given it to a neighbour of thine, that is better than thou. And also the Strength of Israel will not lie nor repent: for he is not a man, that he should repent. Then he said, I have sinned: yet honour me now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God. So Samuel turned again after Saul; and Saul worshipped the **LORD.** 1 Sam 15:24-31

We must not write them off nor refuse them our hand of mercy, but love them still and pray that God will abundantly pardon and forgive them. This is The Church of God, not the General Overseer or some committee, but the same Church that Jesus set in order on the Horns of Hattin. He told them what to do and gave them the explicit

on keeping it The instructions Church of God and the Roman Emperor, Constantine, did not destroy it when the Nicene Creed was adopted; it just lost the theocratic form of government plunging it into darkness. Now God has called each of us to fight the good fight of faith and keep it The Church of God instead of some custom driven, world loving, Devil chasing entity with the lust of the flesh controlling Her right here at the end. On June 13th of 1903, She came lose from the world and its darkness and once again embraced TRUTH and declared Herself to be His Church in every principle of the doctrine that was ONCE delivered to the saints. You nor I can fix it for the preachers that have gone off the deep end and are now receiving any and all that claim salvation without change whatsoever in their lives. If there is no change, then there is no salvation!

Many will call for the rocks and mountains to fall on them in these last days because they have refused to obey God and have resorted to the liberal views of the world they once preached against. I cannot preach to suit the world church and if you do, may God have mercy on you when you stand before Him?

I Peter 4: 12-13 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.

finisher of our faith; who for the
joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the

right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

He paid the price for our salvation, so we will be inexcusable for sin against Him small or great. His blood demands us to be flawless and perfect in the presence of the holiness of God. He said: Be ve holy for I am holy! In order for us to enter into His eternal glory, we must be without spot or wrinkle or any such thing! If we feel any conviction at all, even over the slightest thing, now would be a good time to repent and get it under the blood. Amen.

I Peter 4: 17-18 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?

And again I say, are we ready? The hour is late, children, and the signs that the prophets

and our Lord said would be happening before the rapture are now happening with an unprecedented speed.

Luke 21:28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

These are the most exciting times for us to be alive! We know that He is even at the door and we are pressed in our spirits and souls to quickly make ourselves ready. He wants us to stay in the state of readiness at all times of the day and night. Are we ready to meet our King Jesus face to face?

For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

Again Paul says it in
1 Corinthians 15:51-55 Behold, I
shew you a mystery; We shall not
all sleep, but we shall all be
changed, In a moment, in the
twinkling of an eye, at the last
trump: for the trumpet shall
sound, and the dead shall be
raised incorruptible, and we shall
be changed. For this corruptible

must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

The day that Jesus appears to call us up is our greatest hope. With the world conditions, I feel it is my only hope and I'm glad. There is nothing in this old world that means anything to me any more except The Church of God and my family. We are facing seriously evil times as we watch the greatest courts in the United States make and pass laws that affect millions of people. People will bow down to the evil one and accept these foul and disgusting practices. Many will lose their footing and stumble at the Word of God. Many will forsake God altogether and others will readily agree with anything that this government puts out to the people. But God is not mocked!

Galatians 6:7-9 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

These are promises of God and His promises will come to pass! God is aware of everything that transpires – past, present and future. God is sovereign and His will is prevalent throughout all His creation. This entire world is under His direction! Our God gives no thought, worry or

concern about this pitiful government. He places heads over nations and knows all things at all times and He is not a bit worried about it! 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to usward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

God is a just God as well and will visit this folly and sin and judge the unrighteousness of these that ignore and cast His Word aside and scoff at those who do live godly. God is watching and He will repay.

2 Peter 2:2-10 And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not. us, 3) It seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write unto thee in order, most excellent Theophilus, 4) That thou mightest know the certainty of those things, wherein thou hast been instructed.

There was probably many of them going on, but the Bible tells us about one that was going on at Sister Mary's house, the mother of John. Now, the Bible tells us that Peter was asleep (not lying awake wondering and worrying what was going to happen to him), but was asleep between two soldiers and bound with 2 chains. I suppose the other 14 soldiers were keepers before the prison door. Herod meant that Peter wasn't going anywhere, or was he? Remember what was going on at Sister Mary's house; many were gathered together praying. I don't know how they were praying, but God heard their prayers and He sent an angel to the prison with a light and the light didn't even awake them; not even Peter. So the angel smote Peter on the side and even raised him up without awakening the soldiers. The angel told him to get up quickly and the chains fell off his hands. The two he was sleeping between didn't know a thing. The angel told him to put his shoes and clothes on and to follow him. Now, Peter thought he was seeing a vision. He didn't think this was really happening. So, they went on past wards one and two, not disturbing the other 14 soldiers either. Then they came to the big iron gate that led to the city. Know what happened? The Bible says it opened unto them of its own accord. They went out and passed on through one street and then the angel departed. It was at this time that Peter realized; this is no vision - it is really happening! He thought about it a little bit and decided to go to Sister Mary's house. He knocked on the door and told Rhoda who he was, but she was so excited that she forgot to open the door, but rather took off to tell the others that Peter was there. They said she was mad, but when she kept insisting that it was so, they concluded that it must be his angel. Now, I don't know what they expected, but apparently God did exceeding and abundantly above all that they had

asked or thought. In the meantime, Peter kept knocking on the door and when they finally opened the door and saw him, the Bible said they were astonished! Then he testified to them of how God had brought him out. Has God ever answered a prayer for you in a way that was absolutely astonishing! Think about it!

Oh, we should be sure about one thing. We may not know how God will bring our family, friends, and the lost out of the devil's prison, but if we will pray, and pray, and then pray some more, we will see what God will do, and it will most likely be astonishing to us. The same applies to any situation you are concerned about today. We want to see our churches grow with souls on fire for God and excited about doing His work! Many need financial miracles, but everything belongs to our God. Praise God! It can happen through prayer! I am sure; how about you?

And I, the underside.


Not till the loom is silent And the shuttles cease to fly Shall God unroll the canvas And explain the reason why.




